HARDLY EVER responded to mostly hand urging, moved ahead and had his rider let up some on him in the waning yards. MISS CARTELS SUCCESS broke a bit outward, jostled briefly with RK QUICK VERSION, quickly recovered, was all out and lasted for second. STONES ALIBI was bumped solidly after the start, pressed and could only make up minor ground late. DELTA DANCE also jostled with RK QUICK VERSION at the break and slowly closed the gap the final sixteenth. CASH FLYIN BUD bumped and forced into BERNARDINI at the start, also made up a bit of ground deep stretch. BERNARDINI bumped and forced into STONES ALIBI at the start, chased and lacked a late bid. THE STAR FISH reluctant to load, bobbled inward at the start, bumped CASH FLYING BUD and also only made up minor ground deep stretch. RK QUICK VERSION stumbled inward at the break, jostled briefly between MISS CARTELS SUCCESS and DELTA DANCE and slowly faded the final sixteenth.
