Footnotes

SMITTY broke inward, bumping TIP FROM SKIP, soon had the lead from outside, was clear into the turn, took the rail on the bend, lengthened command upper stretch and maintained control under a mild drive. HONKY TONK GOLD chased from inside, advanced on the turn, came off the rail some as he took over second into the lane, was all out deep stretch and could only close the gap slightly on the leader. SHESTOYOUNGFORUBRO chased from between rivals, was in tight quarters briefly entering the turn three wide, swung out to path five for room into the lane, rallied belatedly the last furlong but drew away from the rest. HINKSON CREEK sent from between horses, was two wide into the bend and also briefly in tight quarters at that point, had the inside for the stretch run and slowly yielded. RAY JAY pressed the early speed from between horses, moved outside SMITTY on the turn and wore down for the drive. TIP FROM SKIP bumped at the start, was prominent just inside SMITTY on the backstretch, four wide taking the turn and also did not have enough left through the lane. FAIRMONT ROUGHEON soon trailed, had the rail on the turn, gradually angled to the outside through the lane but had little to offer.
