Footnotes

FOX RAP was sent to share the lead from inside, moved clear on the second turn, was challenged upper stretch, all out, drifted out briefly under left-handed pressure to brush SUNDAY SAINT with seventy yards to go, was corrected and edged ahead approaching the wire. SUNDAY SAINT advanced inside, waited for room while boxed in on the backstretch, got through two wide nearing the quarter pole, fought outside FOX RAP in the lane, was crowded and brushed slightly near the seventy-yard marker, fought gamely, did not have enough approaching the wire but was easily best of the rest. POWERFULLY contested the pace between horses, was in tight quarters approaching the second turn, could not stay with FOX RAP on that bend, stayed just off the inside, was no match for the pair in the stretch but steadily drew away for the show. UNDER LIKE THUNDER displayed early speed outside POWERFULLY, brushed with that one nearing the second turn then began to fade three wide shortly after that. ROJO PELIGRO was a factor between rivals early but tired from inside on the second bend. MIDNITE KID was away slowly, in contention from outside for five furlongs, moved to the inside on the second turn and gave way. FAST HUTCH pressed from outside but quit two wide on the second turn.
