Footnotes

TAXCO weaved through traffic into the first bend, stalked in hand from three wide, moved clear from outside leaving the second turn, took the rail at the head of the lane, was put to a drive upper stretch and steadily opened up while kept to urging to the wire. GIVING POINTS was hustled up to the lead from between horses, challenged from outside on the backstretch, gained the rail on the second turn, could not stay with TAXCO leaving that bend, came off the rail some entering the stretch, was all out and could only hold onto the place. ARTEMUS JOY brushed with CEDAR KEY SUNSET at the break, vied for the early lead from inside, could not keep up with the top pair approaching the halfway point, saved ground through the second turn, lacked a rally in the lane but was easily best of the rest. ELECTRIC STRIDE void of speed just off the inside, improved position along the rail on the second turn, fanned to path three entering the stretch and failed to have a significant response. RAP ON FELIX soon trailed staying well off the inside, angled in entering the second turn, swung out behind ELECTRIC STRIDE into the lane, altered inside the latter the rest of the way but could not improve his position. SIXTO CALIXTO (MEX) also void of speed while well off the inside, stayed wide taking the second turn, gradually angled in through the stretch and had little to offer. CEDAR KEY SUNSET chased from outside, began to fade just off the inside on the second bend, swung out four wide into the stretch and continued to give way.
