RAISE A GENTLEMAN prominent between horses, angled out four wide on the turn, angled in some entering the stretch, gained the lead nearing the eighth pole, lost it after entering the final furlong but dug in and took it back near the wire. MOROS DESTINY away slowly, advanced between horses, two wide taking the turn, bid inside RAISE A GENTLEMAN, had a narrow advantage inside the last furlong, fought gamely but did not have enough in the waning yards. CIELO'S TIME settled inside, swung outside on the bend, came widest into the lane, steadily closed the gap and caught KEYSTONE KID for third. KEYSTONE KID raced in contention outside from early going, bid four wide in the stretch, had third and an easy striking position nearing the final sixteenth but hung in the late going. RUNAROUND JONNIE disputed the pace inside, had a clear lead at the head of the lane but began to fade with a little more than a furlong left. MARTINI MYST duelled for the lead outside, failed to keep up three wide leaving the turn, altered inside upper stretch and continued to fade. BUCKS GAMBLE vied for the lead just outside RUNAROUND JONNIE, bolted entering the stretch, was eased the last furlong and walked off.
