**Footnotes**

COURT COMPOSER rated well off the early speed, progressed from outside on the backstretch to come into contention three wide on the second turn, came to ONE WILD CAT from outside upper stretch and began to edge ahead in the final strides. ONE WILD CAT soon had the inside and was vying for the lead, moved clear on the second turn, was challenged in the lane, fought gamely, did not have enough nearing the wire but was easily second best. SOUTHERN DREAMER settled inside, commenced his bid into the second turn, gradually angled out, came five wide into the stretch and drew away for third the last sixteenth. NAJFIVE chased from inside, moved to contention along the rail on the second turn but could not sustain his bid through the stretch. MAKE MIKE SMILE an early factor toward the outside, could not keep up on the backstretch and faded between rivals after five furlongs. FRISKAWAY failed to menace in a ground-saving trip. EXACTLY LIKE ME contested the pace just outside ONE WILD CAT, began to yield leaving the second turn, swung out four wide into the stretch and continued to fade. EUROPA'S BEST turned his head just before the gate opened, was slow to be straightened once free to leave the gate, advanced some from outside, was two to four wide taking the second bend and empty for the drive. CATCH THE OUTLAW was soon well back, saved ground and proved unresponsive.
