Footnotes

COUSIN HALEY broke inward, bumping CARRIE ANN SURECAN, was kept close just behind the early speed, swung out on the second turn, advanced three then four wide, was all out in the lane and caught OKEFENOKEE in the final strides. OKEFENOKEE bumped just after the break, shared the lead just off the inside, moved clear along the rail on the second turn, came off the inside some entering the stretch, fought gamely under steady urging deep stretch, was outfinished but easily second best. OLE GRAY boxed in behind the pacesetters for nearly five furlong, could not keep up along the rail on the second turn, gained third upper stretch then battled to the wire to just hold her position. CARRIE ANN SURECAN bumped and forced into OKEFENOKEE at the start, advanced outside to share the lead on the backstretch, could not stay with the latter on the second bend, came three wide into the stretch, fought to regain third but did not have enough late. SASSY BUCK chased from outside, did not stay close while four wide on the second turn, drifted out to path six entering the stretch, showed a willingness to run late and was closing in for third in the waning yards. STEELA displayed early speed between rivals but faded two wide on the second turn. POLLY THE DOLLY soon moved toward the inside, had the rail on the second turn, floated out some into the stretch and had no late bid. MAKIN SOME BUCKS showed little in a wide trip.
