DIXIE'S BACK soon gained the inside, moved ahead on the turn, was clear entering the lane, steadily opened up on the field and proved much the best ridden out. ROYAL RENAISSANCE prominent between rivals, was just off the rail on the turn, swung out for room leaving the turn, drifted out briefly upper stretch, was corrected, took over second inside the last furlong, was all out and could only hold her position. HERE'S DENTON well placed inside, fought for second in the stretch but did not have enough left deep stretch. CAMAGIN fractious in the gate, gradually came off the inside trying to gain a clear path on the backstretch, did not keep close while just off the inside on the turn, swung four wide entering the lane and gradually drifted out as she closed in for third inside the final furlong. SHAKKARENA was hustled along to contest the pace from outside, could not stay with DIXIE'S BACK while just off the inside on the bend, fought to keep second in the lane but wore down inside the final eighth. HALLIE RUTH an early factor between rivals, was caught in tight quarters between horses into the turn, checked while boxed in behind traffic with three furlongs to go, altered out, came five wide into the stretch and had little to offer. ALASKAN PARADOX prominent between horses, gave way three wide on the bend. ABUELA EMMA was checked behind traffic leaving the chute, moved to the outside then faded four wide on the turn.
