Footnotes

HOT DAME shared the lead from outside, was two wide taking the turn, floated out some entering the lane, was slow to respond upper stretch but came back under steady urging and got up in time. SET FOR SPEED unruly behind the gate, was sent to dispute the pace once the race began, saved ground through the turn, moved clear upper stretch, was all out but did not have enough left in the waning yards. ROKEE urged along from inside, improved position on the turn, gradually angled out through the lane, closed strongly, came up short but was clearly best of the rest. LEILANA without early speed between horses, started to advance just off the rail on the bend, was steadied in traffic approaching the quarter pole, had the rail leaving that marker, came off the inside some for the drive and steadily closed the gap. CHICAGO CALI chased from between rivals, progressed two then three wide on the turn then gradually angled in through the stretch as she advanced. DAWNS MISTAKE forwardly placed between horses, took over third four wide on the turn, fanned out further for the stretch run and made up minor ground the last eighth. B DREAMER soon trailed from outside, was three wide on the turn, lost considerable ground fanning seven wide into the lane, angled in some midstretch and was also closing the gap late. UNO BLISS improved position from outside on the backstretch then between rivals on the turn, swung six wide for the stretch run and lacked a significant response. FAT'S GRAY GIRL was an early factor from outside but gave way widest on the bend. GUITAR LADY well placed inside, faded two wide leaving the turn, was pulled up inside the final furlong and walked off.
