Footnotes

OUST settled, moved to the inside early on, gradually progressed along the rail, angled out some for a bid at the leader entering the lane, came to GOLDFINDER inside the final furlong, fought on even terms the rest of the way and got the nod at the wire. GOLDFINDER, fractious behind the gate, was quickly clear and along the rail once the race began, was relaxed and allowed his rivals to close the gap early on the backstretch, let out again near the half mile pole, lengthened command through the second turn, was under a drive in the lane, challenged inside the last eighth, all out, was narrowly outfinished but easily best of the rest. NAFIR'S BEST five wide in close quarters between rivals on the first turn, moved to contention on the backstretch, was three then four wide taking the second bend, battled for third from outside in the stretch, drifted out some with a sixteenth left, was corrected and shook off CHURUBUSCO. The latter showed first, was soon chasing GOLDFINDER from just outside, while in close quarters two wide between horses, his rider lost his whip midway on the second turn, fanned out some for the drive, dueled under hand urging to keep third but did not have enough left late. NORTHERN REVEAL caught six wide on the first wide through the first turn, came into contention from outside on the backstretch, did not keep up four then five wide on the second bend and ran evenly the last quarter mile. FLY BO FLY crowded briefly and angled in some shortly after the break, progressed four wide between horses but began to tire three wide on the second turn. POLAR EXPEDITION altered in some trying to stay clear of FLY BO FLY shortly after the start, bumped DEMIGOD, soon trailed, gradually angled out through the backstretch, stayed well off the rail taking the second turn, moved inside entering the stretch and had no late bid. DEMIGOD bumped shortly after the break, chased three wide to the second bend then tired. DUE TO A POWER OUTAGE, RACES THREE THROUGH EIGHT WERE CANCELLED. A CONSOLATION DAILY DOUBLE FOR THE SECOND AND THIRD RACES WAS PAID.
