Footnotes

PRINCES EVEN crowded at the break, was settled, gradually progressed between horses, moved to contention three wide on the second bend, gained a narrow advantage inside the eighth pole and shook off INTENTIONAL nearing the wire. INTENTIONAL showed first, set a pressured pace from inside, moved ahead on the second turn, was challenged in the lane, did not relent after losing the advantage inside the last eighth but slowly yielded. SHE'S A SLEW a step slow and somewhat awkward at the break, progressed from inside, gradually angled out on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch, steadily advanced and caught AUTUMN GLORY for third near the wire. AUTUMN GLORY prominent three wide from the early going, commenced her bid on the second turn, dueled between rivals upper stretch but did not have enough left late. MIAMAX settled just off the inside, weaved in then out to advance on the second turn, was five wide entering the lane and slowly made up ground. HAGGIS never far off the inside, came into contention along the rail on the second bend then flattened out for the drive. JOHN D'S VALENTINE vied for the early lead just outside INTENTIONAL but faded two wide on the second turn. GOT A SHOT steadily faded running widest.
