Footnotes

LUCKY LIPSTICK stalked from outside, went for the lead three wide on the second turn, was clear into the lane, lugged in some but maintained full control under a mild drive. VERDANT gradually progressed just off the inside, swung out four wide for the drive, took over second upper stretch, was no match for the leader the last eighth but proved easily second best. COUNTRY CAUCUS contested the pace just off the inside but weakened in the stretch and lugged in some with a furlong to go. ZONETTA prominent from inside, was checked as she squeezed through along the rail to avoid the stricken MAGIC MEATBALL just past the half mile marker, saved ground on the second turn, was checked briefly again when her path was taken nearing the eighth pole, came off the rail a bit and finished evenly. GOLDEN TEARDROP trailed from inside, was steadied and altered in to also avoid MAGIC MEATBALL into the second turn, saved ground through that bend and lacked a stretch bid. MAGGIE BEE was a factor between horses to the second bend then gave way just off the inside. MAGIC MEATBALL contested the pace from inside, broke down after a half mile, was pulled up and vanned off.
