CITY PRAYER broke alertly, quickly moved inward, set the pace just off the rail while in hand, was asked to run entering the stretch, drew clear and maintained control under a drive in the lane. MADDIE ROSE bumped with IL FAIT DU SOLEIL at the start, gradually progressed outside to vie for the lead at the quarter pole, gave futile chase four wide under a right whip when the serious running started but proved easily second best. IRON MAIDEN TOO broke somewhat slowly and was steadied as STEEL THE ROSES came close, unhurried inside for the first half mile, swung out on the second turn, lacked a significant bid five wide in the stretch but caught STEEL THE ROSES for third near the wire. STEEL THE ROSES broke inward, swiping the gate, moved outside CITY PRAYER entering the backstretch, pressed the latter through the second turn but weakened in the drive. IL FAIT DU SOLEIL bumped with MADDIE ROSE at the start and failed to menace in a ground-saving trip. YOU'RE SO LUCKY, fractious in the gate before the start, showed little from outside.
