Footnotes

CHICAGO CALI a step slow at the break, gradually progressed inside, found herself boxed in at the head of the lane, got through three wide approaching the furlong marker, took over nearing the sixteenth pole and was driven clear. VERY VERO soon contested the pace from inside, brushed with NANCY'S RAP several times as she fought for the lead upper stretch, was no match for CHICAGO CALI the final sixteenth but edged ahead of NANCY'S RAP. The latter gradually angled in as she vied for the early lead, had a slight advantage two wide on the turn, brushed several times with VERY VERO upper stretch, fought that one to the wire but did not have enough in the waning yards. STORMIN BON also gradually angled in as she dueled for the early lead, was caught in tight quarters between horses midway on the backstretch, taken in hand approaching the half mile marker, three wide through the bend, forced out some upper stretch and could not close the gap on the second flight late. JOLIEJOLIE CAT made a small leap inward at the start, advanced just off the rail, failed to keep up on the turn, fanned four wide entering the lane, altered out further for a clear path midstretch and was gaining on STORMIN BON the last seventy yards. SOPP N WET left the gate with her rider off balance, was angled out as ARISISTER came out approaching the five-furlong marker, clipped that one's heels, was altered in, just off the rail into the bend, gradually swung out to be five wide entering the stretch, came inside when JOLIEJOLIE CAT took her path at the furlong marker and lacked a late bid. ARISISTER hustled along from the start, soon backed up from between horses, moved to the outside for a clear path nearing the end of the first furlong, steadily gave way, stayed well off the inside taking the turn and gradually lugged in through the stretch.
