**Footnotes**

MANHATTAN BEACH in contention between rivals, made his bid four wide on the turn, angled in beside TAILOR'S CUT leaving the bend, battled in the lane, gradually drifted out inside the final sixteenth and shook free nearing the wire. RAVING ROCKET forced in just after the break, jostled with GOLDFELLOW briefly, closed the gap four wide on the turn, lost considerable ground fanning to the middle of the track for the drive, continued his rally and caught TAILOR'S CUT for second in the final strides. TAILOR'S CUT contested the pace from outside, was two wide on the turn, moved clear upper stretch, challenged inside the last eighth, also drifted out in the late going and did not have enough left. TOAST THE GHOST bumped solidly at the start, was an early factor between horses, three wide on the turn, angled in some for the drive, was blocked with a furlong to go, gained a clear path with a sixteenth left and was closing in. GOLDFELLOW jostled about shortly after the break, was without early foot, also three wide on the bend, swung to path six entering the stretch, steadily made up ground and finished on even terms with TOAST THE GHOST. STOP THAT CHARGE broke outward, bumped first with AWESOME RULES then TOAST THE GHOST, quickly recovered to be prominent from inside, found himself boxed in nearing the turn, was steadied several times, gained a clear path four wide at the top of the lane, lacked the needed response upper stretch, lost his path inside the last sixteenth and finished in hand. SAWMILL ROAD without early foot, was two and three wide through the turn, steadily made up ground through the stretch but was too late. SHILOH'S MIRACLE forwardly placed outside, lost ground five wide through the bend and lacked the needed stretch bid. AWESOME RULES bumped at

the start, was then steadied behind rivals, well back while inside, swung out to path five for the drive, closed the gap upper stretch but could not sustain his bid inside the final furlong. BOOK'S BLADE contested the pace from inside to the lane then flattened out.
