### Footnotes

MALIBU SUNRISE was quickly clear, rated on the front end while saving ground, asked leaving the second turn, opened up in the stretch and continued to widen command under late urging. LUCKY TIP advanced inside on the backstretch, came off the rail some as she bid at the leader on the second bend, was all out in the stretch but could only draw away from the rest. STILETTO HEELS angled out three wide leaving the first turn, took over third and came into contention on the second turn, no match for the top pair in the lane but was unchallenged for the show. JOYCE G trailed well off the inside, angled in nearing the second turn, swung out again on that bend, was widest into the lane and had little to offer. SHAKEEL'S BEST gradually faded just off the inside on the backstretch, took the rail leaving the second bend and continued to give way.
