Footnotes

FAIRLY EXPLOSIVE bumped with BELLE'S ERYN shortly after the break, moved up between horses to contest the pace, drew clear from path two on the bend, all out in the lane, lugged in some nearing the wire under right-handed pressure and held on. K L RYDER showed first, vied for the lead, gained the rail on the turn, did not relent from inside through the stretch, hung in the late going, had her path compromised near the wire, altered in a bit and finished in hand. VIRGO VIXEN bumped with UNDER THE VEIL at the break, was blocked behind the early speed on the backstretch, gained a clear path five wide entering the stretch, lacked a late bid but caught BELLE'S ERYN for third in the waning yards. BELLE'S ERYN bumped with FAIRLY EXPLOSIVE after the start, dueled for the lead from outside, three to four wide on the bend then wore down for the stretch run. RESTLESS SHADOW prompted the early pace, failed to keep up from inside on the turn, fanned out to path three for the drive and had little left. COLVILLE ZEAL was a contender along the rail on the backstretch, angled out on the bend, four wide into the lane and also failed to have a late bid. UNDER THE VEIL bumped with VIRGO VIXEN at the start, stayed off the inside throughout and showed little.
