Footnotes

YONA TORY advanced from inside, was angled out three wide midway on the second turn, dueled for the lead in the stretch, had a narrow advantage inside the last furlong and held on under steady handling. CORNEL NOBLE was sent to the lead, moved clear leaving the first turn, showed the way from inside, was roused leaving the second bend, challenged in the lane, fought gamely but had to settle for second best. BALTIC VERSE pressed CORNEL NOBLE from outside, made his bid two wide leaving the second turn, could not stay with the top pair inside the last eighth, angled out some nearing the sixteenth marker and was easily best of the others. AUTO KING an early factor from inside, gradually yielded on the backstretch, was steadied briefly along the rail as his path narrowed midway on the second turn, continued inside and only passed a couple rivals late. ILLINI MO trailed well off the inside, made up some ground as he lodged a mild bid three wide on the second turn, progressed to midstretch then leveled off. JOY FROM PHOENIX was a brief contender toward the outside, failed to keep up on three wide on the backstretch, improved position two wide on the second bend but flattened out between rivals for the drive.
