The latter dueled for the lead inside past midstretch, was no match for the winner but proved easily second best. TREATWITHKIDGLOVES, up close early three wide, drifted out and lugged in through the stretch. SPEEDY TRINA raced five wide without threatening. ABEL MISS DALLAS, bumped at the start, came four wide into the turn, angled to the rail into the stretch and lacked a rally. LIZARD BLIZZARD bumped with ABEL MISS DALLAS at the start and was finished entering the stretch. COT DOT SUE hesitated at the start and was never close outside. FANNY MAY was quickly outrun.
