Footnotes

OURSECONDBUCK was kept close four and five wide, put to the whip once straightened for home, took the lead leaving the furlong marker, was briefly clear and held off the late challenge from PATS LOVE BUG under a steady right whip. PATS LOVE BUG was settled inside, picked up her pace on the turn, angled out into the stretch, split rivals four wide at the eighth pole, came to near even terms with the winner late but lugged in under a right whip. ROBERTA EMPRESS vied for the lead three wide for more than five furlongs but flattened out late. JUST LIKE BOSSY raced in contention five and six wide but weakened outside the final furlong. SPANISH NICOLE battled for the early lead between horses, took a slight advantage after a furlong, was engaged by her rivals from both sides on the turn, dueled between horses in the lane but also flattened out when it counted. ROYAL LIVY was well placed early inside, went for the lead on the turn, contested the pace just past the furlong marker but came up empty at that point and faded.
