Footnotes

CLOUDY Z settled outside, was asked four wide on the turn, had to fan to path eight for the stretch run, was all out, dueled just outside GREATTOBEAVER, gained a narrow advantage inside the sixteenth marker and held on under steady urging. GREATTOBEAVER rated off the early speed, was three wide on the turn, swung out to be just inside CLOUDY Z entering the lane, battled for the lead to the wire, did not have enough late but was easily second best. PALM SPRINGS prominent from outside, was just off the rail on the bend, was carried out to path six into the stretch, lacked the needed bid the final furlong but gained third in the waning yards. HONKY TONK GOLD disputed the pace from outside, two wide on the turn, drifted out to path four entering the stretch and began to tire. CORNER BOY drifted out some to bump WILDWOOD WINNER after the break, was without early speed, had the inside on the bend, floated out to path three for the drive then had to angle in then back out to improve his position. RAY JAY dueled for the lead along or just off the rail but flattened out inside the final eighth. WILDWOOD WINNER bumped after the start, was forwardly placed just off the inside, moved to the rail for a clear path midway on the backstretch, swung outside HONKY TONK GOLD for the drive and faded.
