Footnotes

HONKY TONK GOLD crowded and gradually forced in through the first furlong, brushed with FOXTROT OSCAR midway on the backstretch, had the rail through the bend, moved clear under urging upper stretch and held off Z APPEAL. Z APPEAL bumped then squeezed between rivals at the break, quickly recovered, moved to the rail leaving the bend, angled out three wide upper stretch, closed well but was too late. FOXTROT OSCAR crowded along the rail and steadied after making contact with HONKY TONK GOLD midway on the backstretch, altered out some, had the rail leaving the bend, steadily advanced in the stretch and came off the inside some for a clear path in the waning yards. LORD AND T. vied for the lead from outside, failed to keep up three then four wide leaving the turn and continued to flatten in the lane. LONGEST SHOT failed to menace in a wide trip. RUNNING ON TIME drifted out some just after the break, bumping Z APPEAL, showed no speed between horses, was just off the rail through the turn and had no late bid. SHICAGO SENSATION bumped then squeezed Z APPEAL briefly at the start, steadily angled inward, crowding those inside him, as he disputed the pace, was two wide taking the turn then gave way for the drive. The rider of FOXTROT OSCAR lodged an objection alleging interference from HONKY TONK GOLD near the nine-sixteenths marker. After their review, the stewards determined the interference was initiated by another horse and no action was taken.
