Footnotes

FANTASY MAN settled, progressed just off the rail on the backstretch, waited for room and was checked while boxed in on the second bend, got through two wide into the stretch, floated out further at the head of the lane, took over soon after and drew off under a drive the last eighth. CAP'N FELIX well placed inside from the beginning, waited for a wider path along the rail on the second turn, got through from inside into the lane, threatened, was no match for FANTASY MAN the last furlong but took over second nearing the sixteenth marker. WILL'S HONEY broke inward, bumping SOON, raced in contention from outside, was three to five wide taking the second turn, lacked the extra needed in the lane but caught JOY FROM PHOENIX for third in the waning yards. JOY FROM PHOENIX vigorously urged at the start, set a pressured pace just off the rail, lost the lead upper stretch and slowly yielded between horses inside the last furlong. PEDESTAL settled well back, gradually progressed from inside, swung out four wide for the drive then leveled off the final eighth. SOON bumped and forced into COURTESY TITLE at the start, was an early factor between rivals, faded two wide on the second turn, swung out widest for the stretch run and had little left. COURTESY TITLE bumped at the start, contested the pace outside JOY FROM PHOENIX but gave way three wide leaving the second turn.
