**Footnotes**

BURPEE soon had the advantage just off the inside, moved clear on the bend, was roused in the lane and maintained full control under mild urging. SAM THE RAM vied for the early lead between rivals, could not stay with BURPEE while just off the inside on the turn, angled outside the latter at the top of the stretch, could not close the gap on the leader but gradually pulled away for the place. MYLES MCD prominent from outside, was three then four wide taking the bend, gradually drifted out upper stretch, held a straight path the last eighth and moved clear for third. WEE WILLOW in tight quarters briefly between rivals near the end of the first eighth, backed up nearing the bend, moved to the rail and gradually weakened in the lane. MATT COLE soon trailed from inside, angled out on the bend, came three wide into the stretch and lacked a significant response. SPEEDY MY BOY displayed early speed while toward the outside, was in path three through the turn, began to tire entering the lane, altered in some for a clear path upper stretch and steadily gave way.
