Footnotes

HOPPY'S LONG SHOT rated off the early speed, went for the lead three wide on the turn, had the lead entering the stretch, drew clear, gradually moved inside and held off C C AND MOONLIGHT under urging. C C AND MOONLIGHT was soon well back, advanced from outside, came into contention just off the inside on the bend, fanned four wide into the stretch, rallied belatedly the last eighth, came up short but was easily second best. BRASSY'S BLESSING chased off the inside, swung out widest on the bend, showed a willingness to run late and caught MONARCH THUNDER for third. MONARCH THUNDER contested the pace two wide from the beginning, could not stay with HOPPY'S LONG SHOT upper stretch and began to tire inside the last furlong. DONT SASS MOMMA also void of early speed, came into contention along the rail on the turn, came off the inside some entering the lane and faded between rivals. JACK'S BIG FELLA dueled for the lead from inside for a half mile then began to tire. LOGOLD'S LUCK soon trailed, moved to the inside into the bend, closed the gap along the rail, appeared to balk from a narrow path just inside JACK'S BIG FELLA inside the last furlong, his rider lost his balance temporarily and neither regained momentum.
