Footnotes

BLACKHAWK RED rated between horses, went for the lead three wide into the second turn, angled in some midway on that bend, gained the advantage nearing the furlong marker, moved clear soon after, lugged in under a left whip inside the final sixteenth and held off N EIGHTEEN. The latter was settled, progressed from inside, came off the rail some for room on the second turn, angled three wide for a clear path midstretch, was all out, too late but caught MAC DOOGLE for second. MAC DOOGLE set a pressured pace from inside, could not hold back BLACKHAWK RED in the lane but did not relent, was altered out for a clear path with sixty yards to go but finished evenly. EL RIO ROJO five wide on the first turn, was still five wide as he commenced his bid on the second turn, came into contention leaving that bend and found best stride too late deep stretch. EAGLE EYE JUSTICE in contention four wide from the early going, lacked the extra needed in the lane. KING NEGWER void of speed just off the inside, was three wide leaving the second turn and had no late bid. PROPANE displayed early speed just outside MAC DOOGLE, began to fade early in the second turn, moved to the rail midway on that bend and steadily gave way.
