FULL FORCE took the lead nearing the first bend, moved to the inside early in that turn, was challenged into the second turn, roused leaving that bend, put to a drive nearing the eighth pole, floated out some just inside the furlong marker, edged ahead of TIO CHENCHO with a sixteenth left, moved back to the rail at that point and held sway under steady urging. PARTY KING in contention three wide from the early going, was just off the rail taking the second turn, blocked briefly behind TIO CHENCHO upper stretch, gained a clear path nearing the eighth pole, was three wide at the furlong marker, slowly closed the gap under a steady drive, came in a bit after entering the final sixteenth and caught TIO CHENCHO for second at the wire. TIO CHENCHO steadied briefly when FULL FORCE crossed his path early in the first bend, stalked that one two wide, went for the lead into the second turn, came to even terms with FULL FORCE upper stretch, drifted out to path four near the furlong marker, was corrected but drifted out under left-handed pressure inside the final sixteenth. WHAMMY'S BOY showed first but was soon chasing FULL FORCE, found himself boxed in behind that one on the first turn, did not gain a clear path until midstretch, was tardy taking advantage of his room, lost his path again at the sixteenth marker, was steadied briefly at that point and boxed in to the wire. E DREAMER settled, gradually progressed from paths two or three on the backstretch, was two wide on the second bend, fanned to path four entering the lane, had a striking position with a furlong to go, continued to gain ground but altered out as TIO CHENCHO came out deep stretch. BULL BAYOU bobbled and drifted inward at the break, was void of speed from inside, floated out to path four into the lane, lugged in midstretch and had no late bid. KING NEGWER retreated between rivals going to the first bend, continued to lose position while four then three wide on the backstretch, swung widest into the stretch and was unresponsive. INCLUDE THE BLING moved to the inside leaving the first bend, stayed at the back, saved ground taking the second turn, lacked a stretch bid and came off the rail near the sixteenth pole.
