GO GERT GO broke on top, soon had the inside, shared the lead while in hand on the backstretch, was roused with a quarter mile to go and slowly shook free of A RENOIR under steady urging through the lane. A RENOIR stalked the pacesetter while three wide, made her move on the second turn, angled in beside GO GERT GO midway on that bend, slowly yielded in the stretch but was easily second best. OLE GRAY bumped with JONES TIME at the start, was forwardly placed inside, failed to keep up on the second turn, took over third entering the lane, floated out some midstretch and could only hold her position late. LUCKY TIP soon trailed, saved ground, lodged a mild bid on the second turn, advanced to midstretch then leveled off. PEGASUS PROSPECT in tight along the rail on the first turn, could not stay close on the backstretch, just off the rail on the second bend, swung out to path four into the stretch, was altered out just inside the last furlong and had no late bid. SONGANDDANCELADY gradually backed up from outside, angled in on the second turn, came off the rail some upper stretch and lacked a significant response. JONES TIME bumped with OLE GRAY at the break, vied for the lead just outside GO GERT GO on the backstretch, began to back up two wide on the second bend, fanned out to path three for the drive, started to alter out midstretch, her rider lost his whip inside the furlong marker and she continued to give way. UMMA UMMA slowly faded from between horses, was three wide on the second turn, swung out widest into the lane and also altered out after entering the final eighth.
