LUCKY CHANGE bumped from the rear at the break, moved up quickly inside to vie for the lead after the first furlong, drew clear into the bend, gradually opened up under mild urging in the lane was put to a drive deep stretch and maintained full control. OH MY POSH broke slowly and inward, bumped LUCKY CHANGE, was steadied, well back and along the rail on the backstretch, came off the inside leaving the turn, was four wide into the lane, altered out for a clear path upper stretch, closed strongly, swept past ATS GOOD with seventy yards left and drew away for the place. ATS GOOD caught in traffic shortly after the break, soon moved to the outside, was hustled up, gained second four wide on the turn, gave futile chase to LUCKY CHANGE in the stretch, did not have enough left the final sixteenth and had to settle for third. MOKEE also crowded in traffic early, was a contender between rivals nearing the bend, steadied briefly just off the inside entering the turn, moved to the rail with a quarter mile to go, was blocked upper stretch, began to gradually angle out approaching the eighth pole, lacked the needed response as he continued to angle out deep stretch but improved his position. TIZAMERCEDES was sent to be an early factor along the rail, advanced on the bend but flattened out the last furlong. FIRM MINER quickly angled in to chase the early speed from just off the inside, moved outside STEPHEN'S WHITESOX midway on the backstretch, was three wide on the turn, angled in some entering the stretch and also wore down the final eighth. STEPHEN'S WHITESOX broke on top, was sternly urged from outside, angled in when he moved clear nearing the end of the first furlong, was overtaken from inside nearing the turn and gave way two wide between horses leaving the bend.
