Footnotes

PALM SPRINGS was sent to vie for the lead just off the inside, move clear into the turn, took the rail then steadily lengthened command under mild hand urging in the stretch. KEYSTONE KID broke with the pace but soon dropped back, was urged along from inside, came off the rail near the half mile marker, advanced two wide on the turn, swung out to path five leaving the bend, made a strong move while all out in the stretch and caught EXECUTIVE COACH for second. EXECUTIVE COACH disputed the pace early outside PALM SPRINGS, could not stay with that one while just off the rail into the turn, floated out some entering the stretch and slowly wore down the last sixteenth. ROYAL INTEGRITY broke on top but soon backed up from between rivals, was two to four wide through the turn and could only make up minor ground on second place deep stretch. MASTER COMMANDER steadily dropped back after the break, took the rail near the half mile pole, swung out to path three for the drive, altered out as BORN SUPREME came out upper stretch and found best stride too late. BORN SUPREME prominent from outside, moved to the inside at the half mile marker, failed to keep up on the turn, came off the rail some into the lane, started to drift out upper stretch, was angled back in inside the last eighth and was also closing the gap through the waning yards. LUCKY ALEC away slowly, rushed up from inside to contest the pace, could not keep up with PALM SPRINGS nearing the turn, was steadied briefly when his path was taken into the bend, stayed along the rail and tired the final furlong.
