**BOLD STANDARD** quickly gained the lead, moved ahead just off the rail on the first bend, took the rail on the backstretch, lengthened command when let out some on the second turn, responded to a few shakes of the reins upper stretch, widened further, was ridden out in the late going and held on. **FREEDOM CAMP** rated in paths two or three taking the first turn, angled in some once on the backstretch, was steadied when boxed in briefly behind the fading **PALACHEE** early in the second turn, progressed two wide shortly after that, moved to the rail with a quarter mile to go, rallied, swung out two wide approaching the seventy yard marker, came up a bit short but was easily second best. **MERCURY EXPRESS** showed first, was soon chasing **BOLD STANDARD** from just outside, could not stay close while just off the rail on the second turn, gradually faded through the lane but was unchallenged for third. **AWESOME RULES** a bit slow at the start, moved up between horses, was in tight quarters briefly after being straightened on the backstretch, advanced to contention three wide, angled in some to be just off the rail entering the second turn, gained third, lost position at the top of the stretch, moved outside **MERCURY EXPRESS** approaching the eighth pole and steadily yielded. **PALACE TENOR** trailed from outside, was five wide leaving the first turn, angled in some on the backstretch, was three wide into the second bend, gave way, floated out to path five for the stretch run and had little left. **PALACHEE** was prominent from inside to the second turn then quit.
