Footnotes

COURT COMPOSER settled inside, was roused nearing the half mile point, came into contention four wide on the second turn, gained the advantage from outside just after entering the last eighth then steadily drew off under a drive. COOL BAY stalked the early speed from outside, went for the lead three wide on the second turn, was clear entering the lane, moved to the rail upper stretch, was no match for COURT COMPOSER but was unchallenged for the place. FATHERS BAD BOY vied for the lead just outside UNO MACHO MAN from the early going, could not stay with COOL BAY leaving the second turn, was no match for the top pair in the lane, gradually wore down the last eighth but lasted for the show. R F FLYNPARTNER checked briefly in tight quarters shortly after the break, chased in contention from along or just off the rail, angled five wide upper stretch and was closing the gap for third late. UNO MACHO MAN broke alertly but lugged in some just after the start, contested the pace from inside, began to tire leaving the second turn, angled out three wide upper stretch and continued to flatten. JUNKYARD WARRIOR away a bit slowly, was then checked behind traffic, steadily faded from the rest while well off the inside, saved some ground taking the second turn, floated back out entering the stretch and was unresponsive to brief urging.
