SALSA BREEZE soon had the lead, showed the way just off the inside, was roused into the lane, widened under a drive until the final sixteenth then ridden out the rest of the way. SHAKEEL'S BEST prominent behind SALSA BREEZE on the backstretch, took the rail into the bend, moved clear for second upper stretch, was all out but could only maintain her position. MY MOM ANNA bumped at the start, raced in contention from inside, angled out leaving the turn, drifted to path five entering the lane, lacked a significant bid but gained third late. BE DEE was fractious and flipped behind the gate, showed first once loaded and the race began, was soon pressing SALSA BREEZE from just outside and wore down the last quarter mile. RESTLESS ALLIE void of speed just off the inside, advanced along the rail on the turn, angled out abruptly at the head of the lane, drifted out further and gained some ground late from the middle of the track. ANGELORE without early foot between horses, angled in on the bend and failed to rally along the rail in the stretch. KATE CAN crowded briefly at the start, trailed well off the inside, angled in nearing the turn, swung out to path five for the stretch run and had no late bid. DEPUTY'S SHADOW broke outward, bumping MY MOM ANNA, was steady when the latter took her path after travelling the first sixteenth, altered outside, in paths three or four taking the bend and was empty for the drive.
