Footnotes

BOLD STANDARD broke in stride, set the pace in hand along or just off the rail, widened when let out on the second bend, was roused at the head of the lane, continued to lengthen his lead, was under a drive to the final sixteenth and proved much the best. RIDGELAND AVENUE pressed two or three wide, was no match for BOLD STANDARD when set down for the drive but held PERFECT SAND at bay under steady handling. PERFECT SAND well placed just inside RIDGELAND AVENUE, failed to keep up into the second turn, drew away for third from path three on the second turn, lacked a stretch rally but was unchallenged for the show. PRIVATE BOUND hesitated at the break, was settled off the inside, picked up his pace going to the second turn, in paths three or four through that bend, progressed to midstretch then finished evenly. CAPE FOX without speed just off the inside, split rivals three wide early in the second bend, angled in some leaving that turn, advanced to the last eighth then also leveled off. FORT RENO raced in contention four wide to the second turn then gave way. ACE AFLEET failed to menace in a ground-saving trip. INDY'S TREASURE showed no speed between rivals, two wide on the second turn, was checked lacking a clear path into the stretch and had little to offer in the lane. QUECHEE BOY threw his head about at the start, ran widest throughout and was never a factor.
