Footnotes

PRETTY HEIRESS rated from inside, commenced her bid along the rail leaving the bend, gained the lead inside the final furlong, was clear with a sixteenth to go and held FAITH'S FORTUNE safe under steady urging. FAITH'S FORTUNE contested the pace just off the inside, moved clear on the turn, was forced out some to avoid the loose OCEAN SURGE leaving the bend, all out in the lane but did not have enough left. LUCKY TIP was soon far back and wide to keep clear of the loose horse, moved to the inside midway on the backstretch once the riderless horse was no longer close, picked up her pace on the turn, closed well in the stretch but was too late. RIDGEWAY ANGEL chased from outside, was two wide on the turn, made up some ground upper stretch then leveled off. LIL SUSIE TOO displayed early speed outside FAITH'S FORTUNE, could not stay with that one leaving the bend and gave way widest in the stretch. OCEAN SURGE broke in the air and lost her rider. There was a stewards' inquiry into OCEAN SURGE'S start but no action taken after their review.
