WILDWOOD BELLA broke alertly and soon had the rail, moved ahead on the bend then steadily opened up on the field while under a drive in the lane. GOLDMINE PRINCESS soon moved to the inside, gradually angled out leaving the bend, came widest into the stretch, drifted out some inside the last eighth, was corrected and caught J'S APPROVAL for second at the wire. J'S APPROVAL advanced between horses, was four then five wide taking the turn, gained second midstretch but was outfinished in a game effort. LUCIA BUNS forwardly placed inside from the early going, saved ground through the bend, closed the gap on the second flight upper stretch but leveled off in the late going. TOUGH TALKIN ANNIE contested the pace between horses, came three wide into the stretch, was no match for WILDWOOD BELLA and gradually yielded the final eighth. RANDOM SYN in contention between rivals, failed to keep up just off the rail on the turn, came again two wide upper stretch but hung in the waning yards. NEARLY NEVER NASTY also without early speed, swung five wide for the stretch run and lacked a significant response. HIGHWAY ROBBERY prominent from outside, was three and four wide taking the bend then flattened out from between horses. J G H'S GIRL showed little in a wide trip.
