Footnotes

LUV BANDIT progressed between horses on the backstretch, swiftly circled rivals three wide on the second bend to be clear leaving that turn then steadily lengthened command under a drive in the lane. SIX GUN ROYAL caught five wide on the first turn, moved to the inside after three furlongs, swung out to path three into the stretch and caught his stablemate for second nearing the wire. ROSKI gained the advantage from inside on the first turn, moved ahead on the backstretch, came off the rail some on the second turn, was no match for LUV BANDIT leaving that bend, took the rail into the stretch, was all out, did not have enough left to keep the place in the late going but was easily best of the rest. COPUS jostled between rivals and steadied nearing the first turn, advanced from outside on the backstretch, was widest taking the second bend, drifted out upper stretch, held a straight path the last furlong but finished evenly. DAKOTA'S COURT also caught in crowding and jostled between horses nearing the first bend, was steadied as well, chased just off the inside, saved ground through the second turn and had no late bid. ROYALRAP unruly behind the gate, was hustled to vie for the early lead once the race began, angled in without being clear nearing the first turn, contested the pace just outside ROSKI soon after that, could not stay with the latter nearing the second bend and faded two wide before finishing six furlongs. O'HENNESSY altered in trying to avoid ROYALRAP nearing the first turn, bumped then squeezed DAKOTA'S COURT, was checked off ROYALRAP'S heels just after that, improved position toward the outside on the backstretch but tired three wide on the second turn. THACKER HENRY bumped solidly nearing the first turn, steadily gave way way from inside on the backstretch. There was a stewards' inquiry into the crowding that went on nearing the first turn. After their review, ROYALRAP was disqualified for coming in without being clear, squeezing all inside him, and placed eighth.
