Z APPEAL reluctant to load, vied for the lead from outside once the race began, was two wide through the bend, battled in the lane and shook off BULL BAYOU in the waning yards. BULL BAYOU contested the pace between horses, gained the rail on the turn, tried hard in the stretch but did not have enough left inside the last sixteenth. CHIEFY LOOK without early speed from outside, made his bid four wide on the turn, fought for third in the stretch and edged ahead of LUSK late. LUSK showed first, was soon outrun, gradually altered in to stay clear on the backstretch, came off the rail some to advance on the bend, battled for the show in the lane, did not have enough in the waning yards but was easily best of the rest. JUST LUKE bumped with PERFECT TRIP at the start, chased from between horses, gradually angled out through the turn, came five wide into the lane, improved position upper stretch then leveled off. PERFECT TRIP bumped with JUST LUKE at the break, trailed, was just off the rail taking the bend, angled out widest upper stretch, passed tired ones going to the last furlong then finished evenly. JOHNNIES BREEZE bobbed at the break, improved position along the rail on the turn, altered out some for a clear path upper stretch, bumped MORNING PATRICK and lacked a late bid. MORNING PATRICK gradually angled in as he raced in contention on the backstretch, began to tire two wide on the turn, was bumped nearing the furlong marker and continued to give way. FAST HUTCH displayed early speed from inside, began to fade on the turn, pulled up inside the last furlong and was walked off.
