Footnotes

VANA B hustled along from inside, challenged for the lead nearing the end of the first quarter mile, took the advantage nearing the turn, moved clear when asked approaching the quarter pole, lengthened her lead while under steady urging to inside the last furlong, was put to the whip again deep stretch and added more distance on the field. JEANNIEDUBAI prominent between horses, was three wide into the second turn, came in some as INDY SENORITA moved out at the quarter pole, took over second from path three into the lane, drifted out slightly as she gave futile chase but proved easily second best. WORTHY MISS moved to the inside early on, picked up her pace along the rail on the turn, altered out two wide just inside the final furlong and got up for third nearing the wire. MIAZA void of speed toward the outside, was just off the rail on the bend, fanned three wide for the stretch run, gained third fifty yards out but was outfinished. INDY SENORITA broke outward, rushed up from outside to gain the lead, was challenged nearing the end of the first quarter mile, just off the inside entering the turn, could not stay with VANA B, started to drift out leaving the bend, came into the stretch from path five, was no match for the top pair and gradually wore down the final sixteenth. VERY VERO was a contender from outside on the backstretch but faded four wide on the bend. BABY BABY raced in contention just off the inside on the backstretch, improved her position, though she did not stay close, on the turn, moved to the rail upper stretch and gradually faded the last eighth.
