STUDLEY DORIGHT sent to share the lead from inside, moved clear on the turn, floated out to path three entering the stretch, lengthened his lead, began to wear down and float out the final sixteenth but held on. DEW DETIME caught in crowding shortly after the start, bumped with EVERYINCHARULER near the half mile marker, jostled with that one when again in tight quarters into the bend, advanced just off the rail on the turn, fanned out four wide for the stretch run, closed well inside the leader, was too late but gained second. T BILL BUBBLE jostled briefly after the break, advanced inside, gradually angled out through the turn, came five wide into the stretch, took over second, gradually closed the gap on STUDLEY DORIGHT, altered outside that one near the wire and was also too late. EVERYINCHARULER also in tight quarters shortly after the start, jostled with T BILL BUBBLE briefly, was bumped by DEW DETIME near the half mile marker, jostled with the latter when caught in tight again into the turn, saved ground taking the bend and found best stride too late the final eighth. WHY NORTH displayed early speed just outside STUDLEY DORIGHT, could not stay with that one on the turn, moved in some upper stretch and steadily gave way. LITTLE LUCK chased from between rivals, faded three wide on the bend, was steadied to avoid DOODLE DANDY as he started to float out leaving the turn, came widest into the stretch, continued to give way, was pulled up inside the last furlong and walked off. DOODLE DANDY in the second flight from outside on the backstretch, gave way widest on the turn, pulled up entering the stretch and was vanned off.
