### Footnotes

DEW DETIME soon had the lead just off the inside, moved clear before finishing the first quarter mile, drew off as he saved ground taking the bend then steadily widened command under hand urging in the lane. PEDESTAL rated along or just off the rail on the backstretch, swung out as he commenced his bid leaving the quarter pole, came three wide into the stretch, took over second with a furlong to go, was no match for DEW DETIME but steadily drew off for the place. GREATTOBEABEAVR raced in contention toward the outside on the backstretch, could not stay close to the leader while just off the rail taking the turn, was briefly clear for second upper stretch, headed at the eighth pole, did not have enough left the final furlong but was unchallenged for third. MUSICAL TYPE moved out widest early on and faded three wide on the bend. AMAZING SCORE soon had the rail as he pressed DEW DETIME, could not stay with that one nearing the turn and gave way entering the stretch.
