Footnotes

MR. POSH well placed between horses, went for the lead two wide on the turn, floated out some leaving the bend, moved clear upper stretch, lugged in some under right-handed pressure inside the final furlong, kept a straight path the last sixteenth, was all out under a steady drive and held on. VOYANT kept close four wide between rivals on the backstretch, was three wide into the bend, angled inside at the quarter pole, rallied along the rail, was steadied briefly as he squeezed inside BLACKHAWK RED at the sixteenth marker, closed well but too late. BLACKHAWK RED was hustled up to the lead, took the rail nearing the half mile pole, was headed leaving the turn, did not stay with MR. POSH upper stretch, came off the rail a bit with a furlong to go, battled gamely to the wire but did not have enough left. YOU KNOW U LIED bumped with LUCKY CHANGE at the start, raced in contention from outside, lost ground five wide into the turn, angled in some leaving the bend then drifted out some as he closed the gap deep stretch. RIVER CLIFF moved to the outside approaching the half mile marker, was two wide entering the turn, swung to the outside leaving the bend, drifted out to path six for the drive and slowly drifted out as he passed tired ones. P. J.'S PROSPECTOR was a factor along or just off the rail to the bend then faded. LUCKY CHANGE bumped slightly with YOU KNOW U LIED at the break, helped prompt the pace while toward the outside, four wide into the turn, also angled in some leaving the bend and flattened out for the drive. J T'S OUTLAW unruly in the gate, left his stall with his rider off balance, had no speed while well off the inside, took the rail into the turn, floated out some for the stretch run and had little to offer.
