Footnotes

MISS WHY NOT hustled along to get a clear lead, saved ground through the bend, was roused at the top of the lane and steadily lengthened command while kept to a drive to the last sixteenth. SOARIN SUZANNE broke alertly but soon was chasing MISS WHY NOT, came off the rail some nearing the turn, was under steady urging in the stretch, no match for the leader but proved easily second best. CECI'S FEVER brushed from the rear at the start, was without early speed, moved to the inside approaching the bend, lodged a mild bid from just off the rail in the stretch and gained third in the final strides. TWENTY NINE ROSES without speed, though urged along between rivals, was just off the rail through the turn, angled out some upper stretch, moved clear for third but began to wear down in the waning yards. GARBU GIRL broke inward, bumped SUZANNAH'S STAR and was steadied, improved position three wide on the turn, fanned out further for the drive and was also closing the gap for third late. SUZANNAH'S STAR fractious behind the gate, broke a bit awkwardly and inward, brushing CECI'S FEVER, was then bumped by GARBU GIRL, trailed, stayed well off the rail on the bend, swung widest into the lane and was empty.
