Footnotes

ROYAL TOUR bumped with APACHE HONOR at the break, was kept close, angled out four wide into the bend, fanned out further entering the lane, angled in some upper stretch, moved clear and maintained control ridden out. APACHE HONOR bumped with ROYAL TOUR at the start, was altered in early for a clear path, two wide through the turn, moved to the rail upper stretch, lost his path, was checked, gradually altered out five wide and got up for second late. LOGAN'SSHOREBREEZE contested the pace between horses, two wide on the turn, was carried out some into the lane, also came in some upper stretch, could not stay with ROYAL TOUR, wore down in the late going but was clearly best of the rest. WHAT FOUR DANTE broke inward, vied for the lead between rivals, gained the rail on the turn, floated out some entering the lane, moved back to the rail upper stretch and gradually wore down. JUST VIAREGGIO duelled for the lead from outside, began to back up four wide into the lane, altered out for a clear path upper stretch and continued to yield. SINGALONGWITH BERT whose rider did not carry a whip, was prominent from inside, began to back up along the rail on the turn, came off the inside some for the stretch run and slowly faded. PAJARITO was away slowly, showed no speed, just off the inside on the turn, floated out further into the stretch, gradually angled out through the lane but had no late bid. DO THE DANG THANG was also away slowly, in path three entering the bend, swung out widest into the lane and was empty.
