Footnotes

TWIN POWER vied for the lead while toward the outside, gradually moved in early in the bend, gained the advantage two wide leaving the bend, drew clear upper stretch and maintained full control the last eighth under urging. LITTLE NIBLETS forwardly placed from outside, improved position three wide on the turn, battled for second in the lane and held off ALASKAN PARADOX. The latter contested the pace from inside, was outrun into the bend, waited for room while boxed in behind the leaders through the turn, gained a clear path just off the inside entering the lane, fought for the place, did not have enough late but was easily best of the rest. SMALL KISS duelled for the early lead two wide between horses, also found herself blocked behind the leaders on the turn, swung out four wide for a clear path into the stretch but began to tire. LITTLE JEANNIE displayed early speed three wide between rivals, gained the rail into the turn then gave way for the drive. HONEY UNLIMITED made a small leap from the gate and was in hand until after entering the main track, had the inside leaving the bend, swung widest entering the lane, was unresponsive to urging and eased late.
