HAYQ'S FABLE fractious behind the gate, broke alertly once the race began, was hustled clear, gained the rail into the turn, was put to a drive leaving the bend then steadily opened up with hand urging through the lane. EXPLOSIVE BEN a step slow at the start, quickly advanced between horses, was three wide through the turn, all out the last eighth and caught LAMASK CITY for second near the wire. LAMASK CITY pressed the leader from just outside, floated out some entering the lane, proved no match for HAYQ'S FABLE, gradually drifted out deep stretch and was outfinished for the place. KRACKTOW SHAKER chased from between rivals, was two wide taking the bend, closed well the last furlong but was too late for the show. CRUSIN FORA BRUZIN progressed four wide on the turn, fanned out behind SHAWNEE'S STRIPE into the lane, angled outside that one upper stretch and was closing the gap on the second flight in the late going. COME ON GUY an early factor from inside, weakened the last furlong. BEEFY soon trailed just off the inside, angled outside entering the bend, bolted outward leaving the turn and showed some interest from the middle of the track the final eighth. T HOP in contention early between horses, was checked in traffic nearing the bend, took the turn three wide and could only make up minor ground on the second flight deep stretch. SHAWNEE'S STRIPE advanced five wide on the turn but weakened for the drive. JARBOE soon backed up from between rivals, was four wide through the turn, angled outside upper stretch and steadily gave way.
