RIVER BEAR settled off the early speed, progressed toward the outside, was three wide on the turn, angled in beside ROSKI leaving the bend, took over at the top of the lane, was given slight hand encouragement inside the eighth pole and continued to open up. ROSKI soon moved up between horses to vie for the lead inside ROCKET PROFESSOR, moved ahead and took the rail on the bend, could not stay with RIVER BEAR in the lane, began to wear down inside the last eighth and narrowly held second. CHIEFY LOOK in the second flight from inside on the backstretch, saved ground through the turn, angled out two wide near the sixteenth marker and was closing in for second late. OUR SILVER PEGASUS trailed from outside, was two wide on the turn, swung out again leaving the bend, drifted out to the middle of the track as he straightened for the drive and closed the gap some deep stretch. ROCKET PROFESSOR vied for the lead outside from the beginning but began to wear down two wide leaving the turn.
