Footnotes

BABY WILDCAT rated from inside, swung out to made her bid three wide on the second turn, gained the advantage leaving the bend and gradually angled in then drew off in the lane and was kept to urging until seventy yards out. PARTY DANCE settled toward the outside, angled in some midway on the backstretch, reached contention along the rail on the second turn, came off the inside some leaving that bend, took over second midstretch then could only pull away for that position late. PRIMORYE forced in at the start, trailed from inside, picked up her pace on the second turn, swung widest for the drive and drew off for third deep stretch without threatening the top pair. CAMAGIN unruly behind the gate, displayed early speed from outside, was two wide on the second turn, forced in some leaving that bend then wore down in the lane. ROYAL RENAISSANCE was hustled to set the pace just off or along the rail, was challenged on the backstretch, began to yield in tight quarter leaving the second turn, was steadied when her path narrowed leaving the quarter pole, came off the rail some shortly after that and continued to give way. MISS FEMME FATALE void of speed between horses, moved to the outside midway on the backstretch, was just off the rail through the second turn and empty for the stretch run.
