Footnotes

BALTIC VERSE rated from inside, came off the rail some midway on the backstretch, went for the lead just outside BROTHER DAN on the second turn, took over upper stretch, was clear inside the final furlong, weaved slightly several times but held on under steady urging. FUTURISTIC gradually progressed from inside, threatened midstretch, could not close the gap on the leader the last eighth but shook free for the place. OUST lost ground five wide on the first turn, commenced his bid after a half mile, was three wide into the second bend, lost considerable ground floating out to the middle of the track entering the stretch, made a strong move and got third at the wire. SUNDAY SAINT gradually retreated from between horses on the backstretch, was just off the inside leaving the second turn, altered in twice as he rallied in traffic inside the final furlong and gained third forty yards out. PHIL N MARTY chased while toward the outside, came into contention three wide on the second bend, found himself behind BALTIC VERSE at the top of the lane, subtly rearranged his path several times to stay clear of the latter and finished evenly. FANTASY MAN fractious in the gate, gradually progressed between horses to have a striking position three wide leaving the second turn, drifted out to path five entering the lane and lacked the extra needed deep stretch. MIAMI ICE bumped with A FLEETING MEMORY at the break, was soon far back, picked up his pace after a half mile, saved ground taking the second turn, gradually altered out five wide upper stretch, was steadied behind traffic near the sixteenth marker and altered out again. BROTHER DAN was quickly clear, showed the way just off the inside, challenged from outside on the second turn and gradually wore down in the stretch. A FLEETING MEMORY bumped with MIAMI ICE at the start, stayed wide throughout and showed little.
