Footnotes

SEE YOU THEN CART rated off the early speed from inside, fanned out four wide leaving the bend, lugged in some under a right whip, was corrected, bumped hard with CRIMSON MIST, recovered, rallied between horses under a steady drive and got up at the wire. PIXIE was hustled along to contest the pace just off the inside, did not keep up along the rail on the turn, swung outside SPRING RECITAL for the stretch run, gained the lead going to the eighth pole, was clear with a sixteenth to go but drifted out under a left whip and was outfinished. ROCKABILLIE never far back, lost ground widest through the bend, threatened from outside midstretch but could not close the gap the final furlong. K. B. PARAIISO bumped with MAHIE'S COVERGIRL at the start, was an early contender just off the inside, fanned out behind PIXIE into the lane, was crowded briefly by SEE YOU THEN CART shortly after, angled inside near the eighth pole, had every chance in the late going but finished evenly. MAHIE'S COVERGIRL bumped with K. B. PARAIISO at the break, was settled off the inside, had the rail entering the stretch, made her bid but had to alter out twice inside the final furlong. SPRING RECITAL vied for the lead between horses, moved clear and stayed in path three taking the bend then gradually wore down just off the inside in the lane. CRIMSON MIST displayed early speed outside, began to back up while staying outside SPRING RECITAL on the turn, floated out some entering the stretch, was bumped hard leaving the three-sixteenths marker, steadied, angled outside ROCKABILLIE leaving the eighth pole and continued to fade.
